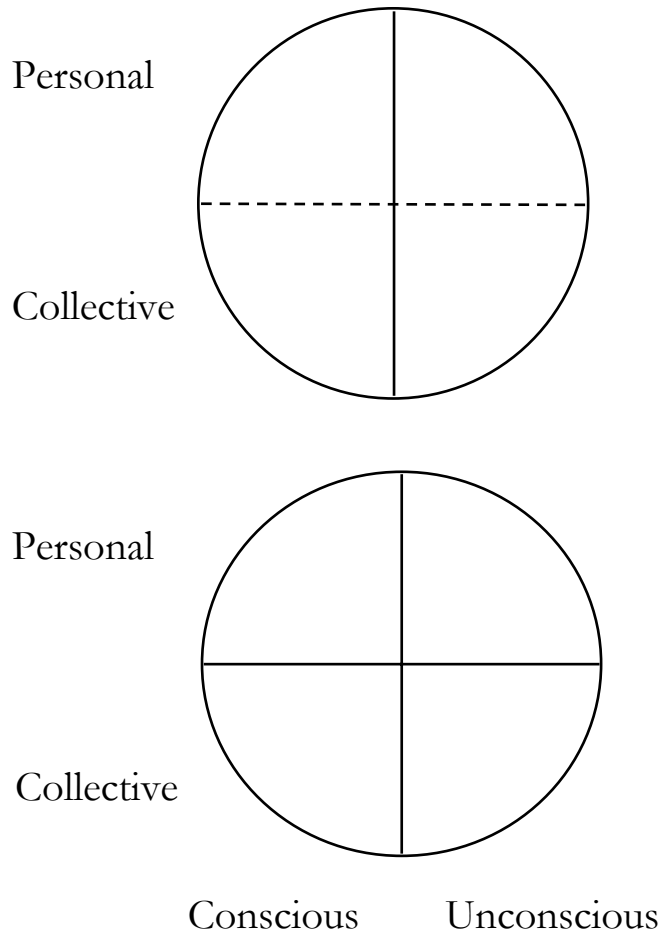
Cycle 2 Life

Stages C & D

Cycle 2 Descriptors

- **Stage C – Man Emerges as an Independent Self**
Stage D – Man Stabilizes and Protects His Fragile “Ego-Self”
- **Second Half of Psyche System Structure Formed**
- **Man Creates Conscious Differentiations**
 - Individual vs. Collective
 - Psyche vs. Body
- **Worldly Life Dominated by Issue of Personal Power, Its Use and Its Control**
- **Sacred Life Dominated by Issue of Direct Intervention of Gods into Life – Polytheistic Gods (Stage C), “One True God” (Stage D)**
- **Written Communication Begins and Developed into Scholarship**

Paradigm – Stage C

Heroic, Early Imperial – Childhood

- Emerged – ~ 8000 BC to 5000 BC
- World Leader – ~ 3500 BC to 500 AD
- Behavior – Egocentric, Selfish, Rebellious, Compulsive, Angry, Brutal, Conditional Relations, No Conscience
- Learning – Operant Learning – Immediate Feedback of Action Consequences. Written Epic Literature
- Action Basis – Authority of Personal Power, Prerogatives of Power, Duties of the Weak.
- Psyche Disease – Delusional Paranoia – Insecurity Fear
- Psyche Pattern – Phase I, Cycle 2, Individual Centered

Paradigm Summary – Stage C

Heroic, Early Imperial – Childhood

Personal Paradigm

- **Self as Separate Being Free of Family & Tribal Domination**
- **Life Is Personal Power, Force, Violence, Godly Sanction, Heroic Pursuit of Personal Destiny**
- **Religion Is Polytheistic, Male & Female Gods, Located on High, Male Dominated**
- **Conditional Relationships – “Are You For Me or Against Me?”**
- **Salvation through Personal Power**

Paradigm Summary – Stage C

Heroic, Early Imperial – Childhood

Collective Paradigm

- **Leadership by Tyrannical Personal Power and Godly Support & Authority Through God/King-Emperors**
- **Organized as Vertical Hierarchy, Single Point Power, Limited Number of Status Levels**
- **Local Kingdoms Became Large Empires by Conquest – Mid-East to Egypt to Rome**
- **Invented Divine Right King/Noble/Common Man/Slave Society – The Feudal System**

Paradigm Summary – Stage C

Heroic, Early Imperial – Childhood

- **Motivation – Become a Separate “Me”, God-Like Personal Power, Get Destiny by Action NOW, “Beat the System”, Be Worshipped as a Hero**
- **Mission – Get and Keep Unchallenged Personal Power in a Hostile World of People and Groups You Cannot Trust**
- **Ends Valued – Personal Position as Powerful, Brave, Heroic. Emotional Security Wanted – Never Achieved.**
- **Means Valued – Manipulation, Coercion, Force, Violence, Infinite Ambition, Pander Gods – Exploit Supporters – Eliminate Opponents**
- **Life Theme – Live by Godly Sanction, Uncontrolled Personal Action to Achieve Personal Destiny by Heroic Action**

Paradigm – Stage D

Absolutistic, Medieval – Adolescence

- Emerged – ~ 1400 BC to 0 AD
- World Leader – ~ 500 AD to 1400 AD
- Behavior – Absolute “Right vs. Wrong”, Intolerant, No Doubt Allowed, Compulsive Conscience, Submissive/Aggressive, Self and Other Critical
- Learning – Avoidant Learning With Delayed Gratification. “Divine Controlled” Knowledge, Science and Law.
- Action Basis – Authority of the “One True God” – Absolute Rules & Standards, Eliminate Personal Will & Dissent, Self-Sacrifice, Martyrdom
- Psyche Disease – Schizophrenia – Insanity of Adolescence
- Psyche Pattern – Phase I, Cycle 2, Collective Centered

Paradigm Summary – Stage D

Absolutistic, Medieval – Adolescence

Personal Paradigm

- **“True Believer”, Absolutistic, Self-Denying, Self Critical, Hypocritical**
- **Believe in Religion Based Scholarship, Science, Government and Law**
- **Believe there is One True Religion, Only Foundation for All Human Affairs**
- **Relationships Are Judgmental and Conditional**
- **Salvation in After Life by Absolute Faith, Submission, Proselytizing, Punishing Evil, Becoming Martyr**

Paradigm Summary – Stage D

Absolutistic, Medieval – Adolescence

Collective Paradigm

- **Invented Bureaucracy – Church Dominated Medieval Society**
- **Leadership by Hierarchic Position and God Granted Power in Authorized Institutions**
- **Organized as Complex, Many Level Bureaucracy, Administered by Absolute Rules and Process Through Human agents of the “One True God”**
- **Religion Claims Universal Jurisdiction Over ALL Human Affairs – Expands Power by Submissive/Aggressive Conquest**

Paradigm Summary – Stage D

Absolutistic, Medieval – Adolescence

- **Motivation – Believe Absolute Truth Exists, Universal, Timeless, Path to Salvation – Behave to Win Salvation**
- **Mission – Be Saved by Absolute Conformity to “Truth” Specified by Authorized Leaders – Break Heroic Will, Atonement Eliminate Heresy**
- **Ends Valued – True Believer, Personal Salvation**
- **Means Valued – Unquestioned Faith, Loyal, Submissive, Aggressive Expansion of the Faith, Guilt, Punishment, Martyrdom**
- **Life Theme – Live by the Universal Truth of the One True God and Prescribed Actions by Superiors**

Conscious Pole (Psyche Open To)

Stage C

**Personal Power – Ego/Self
Separate from Family & Tribe
Domination, Uncontrolled
Power to Grasp One’s Destiny,
Pride & Passion, Rage If
Blocked, Polytheism**

Stage D

**Collective Control of Savage
Human Passions – Belief in One
Absolute Truth to Get Salvation
Eliminate Sin, Submission,
Accusation, Blame, Guilt,
Discipline, Rigid Standards,
Punishment**

Unconscious Pole (Psyche Closed To)

**Opposition or Control of
Personal Wants & Actions,
Shame or Loss of Face for
Failure to Succeed by Heroic
Action, Human Closeness,
Conscience**

**Question or Oppose in Thought
or Action the One Absolute
Truth – Display Heroic Will,
Carnal Appetites, Desire for
Worldly Possessions, Disobey
Authority, Independent Thought
or Action**
